




By implementing an Environmental Management system, Devon Wildlife Trust commits to the following pledges for 2019/20

Objective	Explanation
<p>1. Reduce fleet vehicle emissions to below 40 tonnes CO2</p> 	<p><i>Vehicle emissions continue to rise through excessive vehicle use. Last year emissions rose by 2 tonnes. If successful, this objective would see us reduce by the same amount and begin a trend of reduction</i></p>
<p>2. Reduce private mileage emissions to below 16 tonnes CO2</p> 	<p><i>The use of personal vehicles for work purposes reduced last year and the associated CO2 emissions reduced accordingly. We have managed a reduction of 2 tonnes in each of the past two years so would like to see this trend continue</i></p>
<p>3. Reduce energy consumption at Seaton Jurassic by 10%</p> 	<p><i>Seaton Jurassic energy use has been higher than anticipated for the past three years. Much work has been done to re-programme the plant equipment on site and with good controls we hope to see a significant reduction in 2019/20</i></p>
<p>4. Complete energy audit at Woodah Farm</p> 	<p><i>Energy consumption at Woodah Farm is erratic. We plan to audit the site using the same methods employed with success at Seaton Jurassic last year with an aim of significantly reducing energy use</i></p>
<p>5. Reduce energy at Woodah Farm by 20%</p> 	<p><i>It is anticipated that the energy audit will see a reduction of 20% or more</i></p>
