



Make A Paper Plate Leatherback Turtle

What you will need:

- Paper plate
- Tissue paper (black and white)
- Card or thick paper (black)
- Glue (Pritt Stick or PVA)
- Paint brush (if using PVA)
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Googly eyes (if you have them)



Instructions

- 1. Cut or tear your black tissue paper into squares
- 2. Tear your white tissue paper into very small pieces/dots
- 3. Using the card, cut out 4 flippers, 1 head and 1 tail (draw stencil first or use image as a guide if needed)
- 4. Attach googly eyes to head piece or use white tissue paper and stick eyes on
- 5. For the shell, use the paint/glue brush to smother the back of your paper plate
- 6. Completely cover the paper plate in black tissue paper and leave to dry
- 7. Once dried, glue on white tissue paper dots over the top and leave to dry
- 8. Once fully dried, attach the flippers, head and tail to the paper using a stapler

Voilà, you have a paper plate Leatherback turtle!
