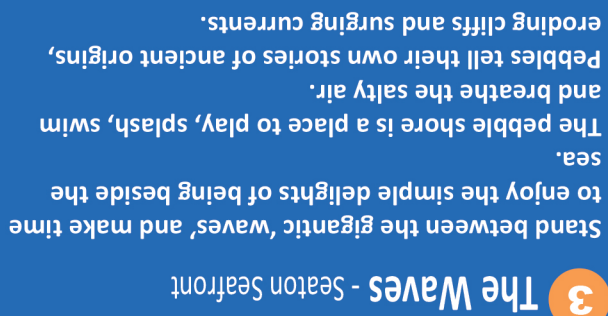

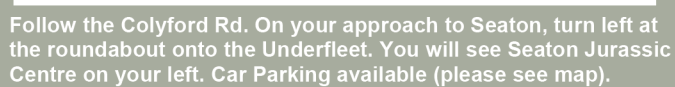

All directions start from Seaton Jurassic

1 The Stargazer - Seaton Wetlands (25 minute walk/ 1.3 miles)
Turn right and take the footpath adjacent to the Jurassic play park. Follow the path all the way to the Water Works. Turn left until you reach the Colyford Rd, turn right and walk to Seaton Cemetery. Walk through to Wetlands car park and follow the signs to the Discovery Hut. The Stargazer is immediately in front of it. **(Dogs not allowed)**

By car

Turn right, and at the roundabout turn right onto Colyford Road.
Follow the road until you reach Seaton Cemetery on the right.
Drive through to Seaton Wetlands car park, then continue as above.

2 The Prow – Axmouth *(15 minute walk/ 0.7 miles)*
Turn left towards Harbour Rd, past the Tram Station, turn left and continue walking until you reach Axe Yacht Club.
Cross over the Axmouth Bridge. Turn right down the footpath alongside the harbour until you reach the Prow on your left.

By car

Turn left onto Harbour Rd, towards Axmouth Harbour. Parking can be found just over Axmouth Bridge on the right hand side.

3 The Waves - Seaton Sea Front *(7 minute walk/ 0.3 miles)*
Head towards the seafront across Harbour Road, turn right and follow the road to Marine Place where you will see the Waves at Fisherman's Gap, on the promenade.

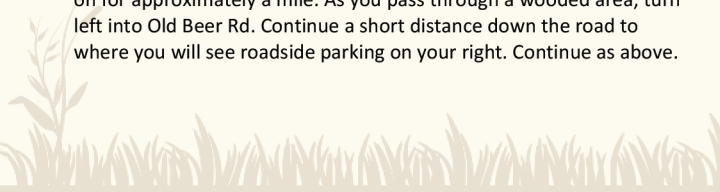
By car

Head to Seaton sea front where you will find parking available along side the Seaton promenade.

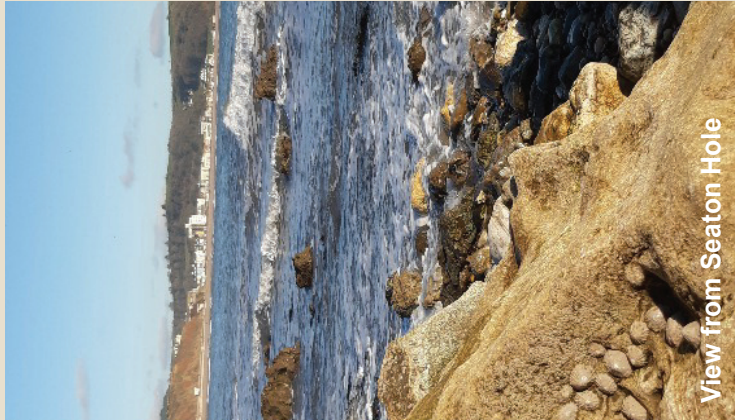
4 The Portal - Seaton Hole *(20 minute walk/ 0.9 miles)*
Turn left and head to the seafront. Turn right and walk to the end of the promenade. If the tide is out you can walk along the pebble beach directly to Seaton Hole. The Portal is at the top of the cliff. If the tide is in, turn right past the cafe and walk up the hill to Beer Rd. Turn left and follow the road to the top of the hill, where you will see a public footpath sign on the left. This will take you through a small wooded area and down a steep hill. Turn left at the gate and walk up Old Beer Rd until you reach the cafe. Bear right towards Seaton Hole beach, the Portal is on your right.

By car

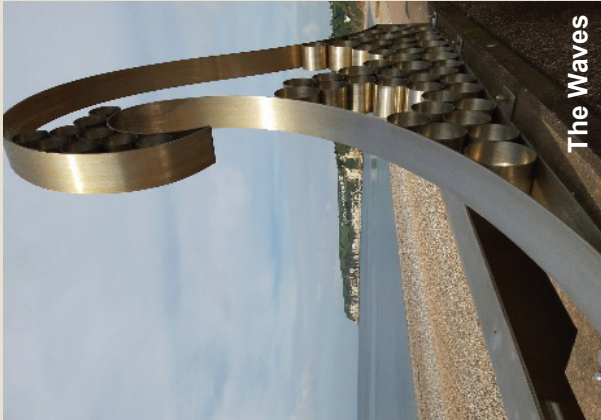
Turn right, then left at the roundabout into Fore St. Follow the road through the town centre until you arrive at a road junction. Turn left, then immediately right into Beer Rd and continue on for approximately a mile. As you pass through a wooded area, turn left into Old Beer Rd. Continue a short distance down the road to where you will see roadside parking on your right. Continue as above.

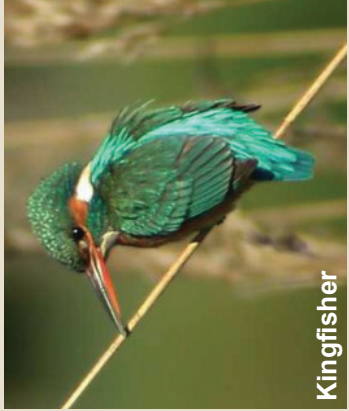
