






By implementing an Environmental Management system, Devon Wildlife Trust commits to the following pledges for 2020/21

Objective	Explanation
<p>1. Establish Carbon Footprint for the Trust</p> 	<p><i>This will provide a baseline for year 1 and will form part of the ambition to become Carbon Neutral by 2030. At this stage the footprint will be comprised solely of scope 1 and scope 2 emissions</i></p>
<p>2. Reduce fleet vehicle emissions to below 30 tonnes CO2</p> 	<p><i>Last year, emissions reduced by 6 tonnes. Given the restrictions caused by COVID19 and the associated changes to working practices, it is hoped that we can significantly improve on this amount over the next 12 months</i></p>
<p>3. Adopt new emission monitoring being used by the Wildlife Trusts to ensure a consistent Carbon Footprint going forward</p> 	<p><i>DWT is working with the Wildlife Trusts in the production of a Caron calculation methodology across all regional Trusts. By adopting this, DWT can ensure a reliable and repeatable carbon footprint is calculated on an annual basis</i></p>
<p>4. Review the energy efficiency and heating options for all DWT properties</p> 	<p><i>Not all DWT offices are as energy efficient as we would like. A review is required to identify the areas in which improvements to reduce CO2e emissions is required and this will allow DWT to plan a programme of redevelopment in the coming years</i></p>
<p>5. Move all DWT energy contracts to 100% renewable tariffs</p> 	<p><i>This will significantly improve the Scope 2 emissions associated with the running of our buildings</i></p>
