

Dormouse

Lost from much of England, Devon remains a dormouse stronghold. But even here, loss of woodland and of ash trees from hedges means pressure on the places dormice use for nesting, food and hibernating. Many DWT reserves provide secure nesting sites and ample feeding opportunities for dormice. This is thanks to DWT's management of these habitats, including the coppiced hazel woodland of Lady's Wood, near South Brent, and the hedges at Meeth Quarry, near Torrington.
