Heath lobelia

Once found across southern England the heath lobelia has disappeared from much of its former range due to the loss of heath and species-rich grassland habitats. The largest colony of heath lobelia plants in the UK is found at DWT's Andrew's Wood nature reserve, in the Avon Valley. Patches of woodland that succeeded abandoned farmland on this site in the early 20th century are interspersed with open areas, where the heath lobelia grows in abundance. **DWT continues to manage the habitats at this wonderful reserve so this balance of woodland and wildflower-rich grassland continues to provide a home to a wide array of wildlife.**
