## Willow tit

In England, willow tits declined by a shocking 81% in the last 25 years. Devon still has isolated populations, largely in the north of the county. **DWT's Culm grassland reserves support these busy birds.** Areas of scrub on these sites are where willow tits find damp wood to excavate their nest holes, while food can be found among the insect-rich grasslands and hedgerow trees on reserves such as Dunsdon, near Holsworthy.
