

Willow tit

In England, willow tits declined by a shocking 81% in the last 25 years. Devon still has isolated populations, largely in the north of the county. DWT's Culm grassland reserves support these busy birds. Areas of scrub on these sites are where willow tits find damp wood to excavate their nest holes, while food can be found among the insect-rich grasslands and hedgerow trees on reserves such as Dunsdon, near Holsworthy.
