April 28th - Roborough Wood, West Down

Exploring the flora and other wildlife of this ancient woodland in spring-time. Meet in the square at West Down SS515/421.

May 5th - Weare Giffard

A wood in Spring - a circular walk to look at an abundance of woodland flora including a beautiful Devon special species - Bastard Balm, along with the rare Wild Service Tree. Meet at SS47308/22153, EX39 4QS - plenty of roadside parking. Leader: Mary Breeds.

May 12th - Bucks Mills
